This is to Certify that

Senior Division, Officers Training Corps, has fulfilled the necessary conditions as to efficient service, and has qualified in the Medical syllabus of examination, as laid down in the Regulation for the Officers Training Corps. He is, therefore, eligible for special consideration for a commission in the Regular Army as a University Candidate, in the Supplementary Reserve, Territorial Army, Territorial Army Reserve of Officers, or Active Militia of Canada.

(b) Offering himself as a candidate for—

he will be entitled to the privileges conferred on holders of this Certificate as set forth in the Regulations concerned, and to any further privileges that may be authorised after the date of this Certificate.
