Concentrated carbolic acid: to be well diluted before use, according to the directions on the label and case: for the household, sick room, stable, kennel, etc.: poison.

CONCENTRATED CARBOLIC ACID.

To be well diluted before use, according to the directions on the Label and Case

FOR THE HOUSEHOLD, SICK ROOM, STABLE, KENNEL, ETC.

POISON

DIRECTIONS.

LINEN, CLOTHING, ETC.—To disinfect, soak in water containing one wineglassful of acid in each gallon.

SINKS, CLOSETS, DRAINS, ETC. — Flush daily with a solution containing a teaspoonful of acid in a pint of water.

IN THE SICK ROOM, in cases of fever and infectious diseases, and to remove objectionable odours, sprinkle the floor and rinse all vessels with a solution of one part of the acid in 100 of water. Place solutions of the same strength in saucers on the floor, also in night commodes before use. A sheet wetted with the liquid should be kept suspended outside the door.
