

DIRECTIONS.

For Sprains, Curbs, &c. in Horses.

Foment well with hot water and rub the Embrocation in with the hand, twice a day, for four or five days.

For Fresh Cuts, Sore Shoulders, Raw Backs, &c

Wash with luke-warm water, and apply the Embrocation to the effected part on a piece of clean linen, repeat twice a day. In some cases the Embrocation should be diluted with one or more parts of cold water, according to the nature of the wound.

For Blistering.

Rub in well with the hand, then apply on a piece of rag, and bind with cold wet bandage. Repeat night and morning till a scurf is raised.

For Sore Throats and Influenza.

Rub in all down the throat and over the chest with the hand night & morning

In all cases of broken Knees and Sores, well clean the part before applying the Embrocation.

DIRECTIONS.

FOR SPRAINS, CURBS, Etc., IN HORSES-Foment well with hot water and rub the Embrocation in with the hand, twice a day for four or five days. FOR FRESH CUTS, SORE SHOULDERS, RAW BACKS, Etc Wash with luke-warm water, and apply the Embrocation to the affected parts on a piece of clean linen repeat twice aday in some cases the Embrocation should be diluted with one or more parts of cold water according to the nature of the wound.

FOR BLISTERING-Rub in well with the hand, then apply on a piece of

FOR BLISTERING.-Rub in well with the hand, then apply on a piece of rag, and bind with cold wet bandages Repeat night and morning till a scurf is raised.

FOR SORE THROATS AND INFLUENZA.-Rub in all down the throat and over the Chest with the handnight and morning.

In all cases of Broken Knees and Sores well clean the part before applying the Embrocation.
