**DIRECTIONS.**—For Wounds, Warbles, or Galled Backs, &c., where the part injured is small, a little may be applied with a feather; but if large, it will be necessary to wet a pledget of tow or linen rag, and apply. For Bruises, Sprains, Swellings, &c., when the Skin, is not broken, the part to be well rubbed with the Mixture twice a day.
