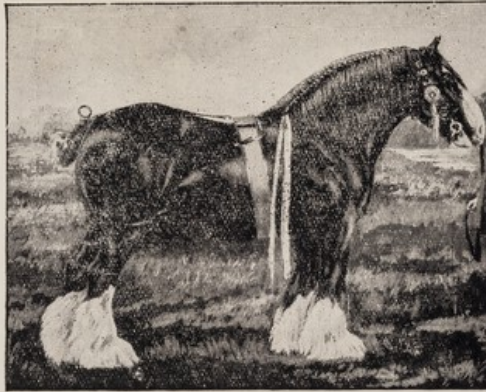

DIRECTIONS FOR USE.

FOR A HORSE.—At each time of feeding give one measureful of the "STUD" COD LIVER OIL CONDIMENT in the usual chop or corn. It will cause the animal to thrive and eat better and produce a healthy constitution, and give a glossy coat.

FOR A PIG.—At each time of feeding mix one measureful with the usual food and give regularly, and the result will be noticed in a very few days, being especially beneficial for purifying the blood and causing pigs to thrive and fatten very quickly.



It is an excellent thing for Pheasants, Ducks, Geese, Poultry, and Rabbits. Give one measureful to a dozen birds twice a day, mixed with the usual soft food.

A measure is included with every barrel of the "STUD" COD LIVER OIL CONDIMENT.



FOR A COW.—Two measures full twice a day with the usual chaff and meal damped. It will produce a greater supply of milk, of a much richer quality. It is invaluable for beasts mawbound, or hidebound, keeping the skin in a nice loose condition, and making beef more rapidly.

FOR A BULLOCK.—Mix the same as for a cow, and it will produce beef much more rapidly and superior in quality.

FOR CALVES.—A measureful mixed with the usual quantity of food will be found sufficient for eight, and they will thrive and grow much better, with more bone, and a robust constitution.

FOR SHEEP.—Two measures full to every eight sheep at each time of feeding; damp the chaff and mix up together. It gives the most beneficial results.
