Notice to V.A.D. Members applying for Special Service.

QUALIFICATION FORM Must be carefully filled in and returned to your Commandant.

MEDICAL CERTIFICATE Must be handed to your Doctor or the Medical Officer of your Detachment, and must be returned to us direct by him. *also to Commandant.*

Be careful to enter your Name and Detachment County and Number before handing it to the Doctor.

INTERVIEW Before being finally selected you are obliged to have a personal interview with the representative appointed by the Selection Board, either at this Office or at another centre. You will receive further instructions as to your interview when you have returned your Qualification Form and Medical Certificate.

INOCULATION Inoculation against enteric is not a necessity but it is most desirable. It would be well to be inoculated to avoid delay after selection (though of course to be inoculated does not guarantee that you will be selected). If on this understanding you are being inoculated at once, please write your name and number of your Detachment on the enclosed certificate and have it signed by your doctor, and sent to us directly your inoculation is complete.

After we have received your Qualification Form, on application to Devonshire House, London Members will be given an order, if desired, for inoculation at St. Mary's, Paddington.

On application to Devonshire House, Country Members can have vaccine sent gratis to their medical adviser (whose name and address should be given).

AGE It is necessary that this shall be entered accurately and conscientiously. The Member's signature on the form is considered an honourable guarantee that all entries on the form are correct.
