and must be produced to the Retailer upon every purchase of sugar in respect of that person.

NOTE.—The space above for the householder's name and Part A on the back must be filled up immediately upon the issue of this Ticket, and in any case before it is produced to the Retailer.

### TRANSFER ON REMOVAL, Etc.

If the person named on the back removes altogether or ceases to be a member of the above-mentioned household, Part B on the back should be filled up and the Ticket should then be taken to a Post Office.
