

THE BLOODLESS CASTRATOR BURDIZZO PATTERN

FOR

Horses, Bulls, Sheep, Pigs, etc.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE.

Secure the animal firmly by the head to a post or any substantial support.

Bulls should be operated on standing. Horses, sheep and pigs, are preferably thrown. With smaller animals, it is sufficient to secure the services of an assistant, to hold the animal in his arms.

Standing behind the animal, the Operator should pull one testicle well down into the bag. Holding the instrument, with the jaws ready open in one hand, the Spermatic Cord can be located, and held against the side of the bag. Where the cord is held, place the jaws of the instrument. Close the instrument against the cord a little above the testicle. Having ensured that the cord is gripped, press the handles with both hands hard until the jaws are completely closed.

A second compression should be made immediately on the same cords a little higher, to crush the cord in two distinct places.


The operation is then repeated, in exactly the same manner with the other cord, when castration is complete.

IMPORTANT.—Make certain that the cord is gripped in the jaws of the instrument otherwise the operation will be ineffective. The second crushing on the same cord is to ensure that the severance of each cord is successfully carried out.

The testicles will shrink and become useless, the process taking from four to six weeks. There is no bleeding, the outer skin is not cut, and the animal will not lose condition, or need further treatment.

The Operation on these is quickly performed, in the manner indicated overleaf. The animal is usually firmly held in a convenient position by an assistant, whilst the operator performs the same details, as for the larger animals.
