

CORD-HOLDING FORCEPS (R. L. Lewis) Prov. Pat. 1657.

These Forceps have been devised as a result of considerable experience in the use of the "Burdizzo" Castrator, and with a view to rendering the latter foolproof, and the operation of castration certain.

The object is to prevent escape of the Spermatic Cord from the jaws of the castrator, which does not infrequently occur, and thereby necessitating a second operation.

The inventor claims that escape of the cord is impossible, and that, in most cases, it is quite unnecessary to crush the cord in more than one position, the forceps aiding the complete severance of the Spermatic vessels at one squeeze of the pincers.

Can be used on ANY Animal upon which the "Burdizzo," or any similar castrator, is used, either in the standing or recumbent position.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE.

The Forceps are placed in position from the left side, gripping the scrotum between the two spermatic cords. The "Burdizzo" or any similar castrator, is then applied as in the usual method of castration, but in the space provided between the bifurcated jaws of the forceps. The operation on the right spermatic cord is completed in the ordinary way by closing the jaws of the castrator. The operation is performed in the same manner on the left spermatic cord by changing the position of the forceps, that is, by fixing it between the two cords from the right side. The forceps are held in position by an assistant.
