For a CALF, One powder to be given in gruel, and repeated next day if necessary.

" PIG, Give half a powder, and for a sucking pig a quarter of a powder.

SCOURING OR DIARRHOEA IN CALVES is often the cause of very serious loss to owners, the frequent form is found in artificially-reared Calves, and is of the white kind. Before administering the powders give a dose of Castor Oil, from half-an-ounce to two ounces and the addition of one-fourth part of Lime Water with fresh milk will befound advantageous.
