Leeming's Essence,

Cameness in Horses. POISON.

This Essence cures Claps or Strains of the Back Sinews, also Slips and Strains of the Shoulders, Stifle Hough, Whirlbone, Knee Fetlock, Pastern and Coffin Joints.

When newly done, mix two or three tea-spoonfuls of the Essence with three times as much Rum or Brandy, rub it on the part, and if not well in twenty-four-hours, repeat it.
