The following is a wonderful all-round Record:—

On the Turf he started 44 times. Won 9 times.
Total £3000 Placed 12 times.

In the Show Ring he has won King's Premiums in 1911, 1912, 1913, 1914, and Super-Premiums in the three latter years. He was also first at Tunbridge Wells in 1912 and 1913.

As a Sire he holds the highest per centage of Foals per mares of any stallion subsidised by the Government, as shewn in the last published report; his per centage being officially returned as 85.71, the average of all the horses being 58.18.

His produce, besides many prizes at Local and County Shows, have at the London Show won the Yearling Filly Class three years out of the last four, also the 3-year-old Filly Class this year. Other Fillies by him were 2nd in the 2-year-old Class, and 3rd and 5th in the 3-year-old Class. Five other Premiums were won by his Stock in 1912, 1913, and 1914.

He is also Sire of the winning "Produce Group" of 1915.

At the Royal in 1912, Fillies by him were 2nd and 3rd; in 1913 one won; in 1914 one won and another was second.
