

DIRECTIONS.


Dose :—

HORSES. Ordinary Horse, One Ball ; small Horse or Horse much out of Condition, Two-thirds of a Ball ; small Pony, Half-a-Ball ; large Cart Horse, Ball-and-a-half, once a week for 3 weeks, then wait 3 weeks or a month and repeat.

 If there is a difficulty in giving a Ball, beat it into a coarse powder and mix in COLD Gruel, and give as a Drink.

CATTLE. A Cow, or full-sized Beast, a Ball-and-a-half ; a Yearling or small Cow, One Ball ; a Calf three months old, Three-fourths-of-a-Ball ; a Calf three or four weeks old, Half-a-Ball, once a week for 3 weeks.

SHEEP. If full size and strong, Half-a-Ball ; Lambs, a Fourth-of-a-Ball, once a week for 3 weeks.

 For Cattle and Sheep, beat the Ball into a coarse powder and mix in COLD Gruel and give as a Drink.
