DIRECTIONS

When giving a Ball hold in hand before fire until soft.

If difficult to administer to the Horse beat into a coarse powder on a cold stone, mix with cold gruel (1 pint) and give as a drench. When giving as a drench do not apply heat or the particles will stick together.

The Balls will not Dissolve.

Give a Cupiss' Grease Ball once a week for three doses and repeat if necessary after an interval of 10 days.

Keep the Horses legs as dry as is possible, after washing the legs make sure they are thoroughly dried off and that the Stable floor is dry and not draughty.

These Balls will keep any length of time in a cool dry place.

DOSES

Ordinary Horse : One Ball. Small Horse : Two Thirds of a Ball. Small Pony : Half of a Ball. Large Cart Horse : One Ball and a Half.
