OINTMENT FOR THE SCAB IN SHEEP



The mode of applying the Ointment is to begin at the head of Sheep, and proceeding from between the ears along the back to the end of the tail; divide the wool in a furrow till the skin can be touched, and let a finger slightly dipped in the Ointment be drawn along the bottom of the furrow, from this furrow similar ones must be drawn along the other parts. It kills the sheep fag, tick and other vermin.
