DIRECTIONS FOR USE.

Add the contents of this one gallon tin to 70 gallons of warm water and stir thoroughly. When dipping the sheep keep the mixture well stirred and do not allow any of the liquid to enter the eyes, nostrils or mouth of the animal.

Each sheep, should be immersed for fully half a minute and the temperature of the dip should be about 100° F.
