# A. GARSTIN & Co.'s (ONLY PRIZE MEDALS AWARDED FOR) DOG COLLARS.

The following Order has been made by the Board of Agriculture, published in the "Gazette":

(EXTRACT.)

"That all Dogs WHICH HAVE ON A COLLAR, with the Name and Address of Owner legibly engraved thereon, shall be exempt from the Muzzling Order of 1889, IN THE FOLLOWING DISTRICTS ONLY":

### DISTRICTS AND PARTS OF DISTRICTS OF LOCAL AUTHORITIES TO WHICH THIS ORDER APPLIES.

County of Essex (part outside the Metropolitan Police District), Borough of Colchester; County of Hertford (part outside the Metropolitan Police District), Borough of St. Albans; County of Kent (part outside the Metropolitan Police District), Boroughs of Canterbury, Dover, Folkestone, Gravesend, Maidstone, Margate, Ramsgate, Rochester, and Tunbridge Wells; County of Surrey (part outside the Metropolitan Police District), Boroughs of Guildford and Reigate.
