being disloyal, those who 'blow the whistle' on cruel or negligent practices in animal research laboratories are acting in the

public interest and deserve all the praise they receive.

If you help us you will be in good company. For example, it was inside information from the Biosearch Laboratories in the USA, that led to revelations that Benetton were using rabbits in

cosmetic tests; information which, when publicised in the *Daily Mirror*, caused the company to reject animal experiments. So your

information could bring about changes for the better.
