## CONSTITUTION.

I. That the Society be called the "ABERDEEN UNIVERSITY ANATOMICAL AND ANTHROPOLOGICAL SOCIETY".

II. That the objects of the Society be the discussion of subjects connected with Anatomical and Anthropological research by means of written papers, lectures and demonstrations, and that it should help in every way towards the formation of a general Anthropological Museum in the University.

III. That the membership of the Society be open to all matriculated students and to others interested in such work, and that those who, by presentation of collections and specimens of Anatomical and Anthropological interest, have become benefactors of the Society, shall be appointed honorary members, as the ordinary members determine.

IV. That the annual subscription be one shilling and sixpence, and that the published Transactions of the Society be issued to members and to non-members at whatever price shall be determined by the Committee of Management. Members may become life members on payment of seven shillings and sixpence, from which the amount of subscription previously paid shall be deducted.

V. That the Society be managed by a Committee consisting of a President, three Vice-Presidents, a Secretary, a Recording Secretary and a Treasurer, all of whom be appointed at the last ordinary meeting of the Summer Session.

VI. That the Society meet once in a month, if possible, during the Winter and Summer Sessions, in the Anatomical Department, on Saturdays, at 10 o'clock A.M.
