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DIRECTIONS FOR USE.

STRONG BEEF TEA.—Dissolve a teaspoonful of the Extract in a pint of Boiling Water, to which add a little Pepper and Salt, &c. at discretion, a little Toast and a few Herbs are a great addition.

GRAVY.—Dissolve two small teaspoonfuls of the Extract in a pint of water thicken with Flour and Butter, and flavour according to taste.

FOR INVALIDS nothing is necessary to be added but what is appropriate or palatable.

STOCK may be made by using as much Extract as is wished, understanding 1-oz represents a pound of Meat.
