## Ingredients

30ml/2 tbsp vegetable oil 1 onion, sliced 2 courgettes, finely sliced 6 Lion Quality eggs 75g/3oz Cheddar cheese, grated

### Method

Heat the oil in a frying pan, add onions fry for 2 minutes until soft. Add courgettes and fry for 4 minutes until golden. Beat eggs with salt and freshly ground black pepper.
