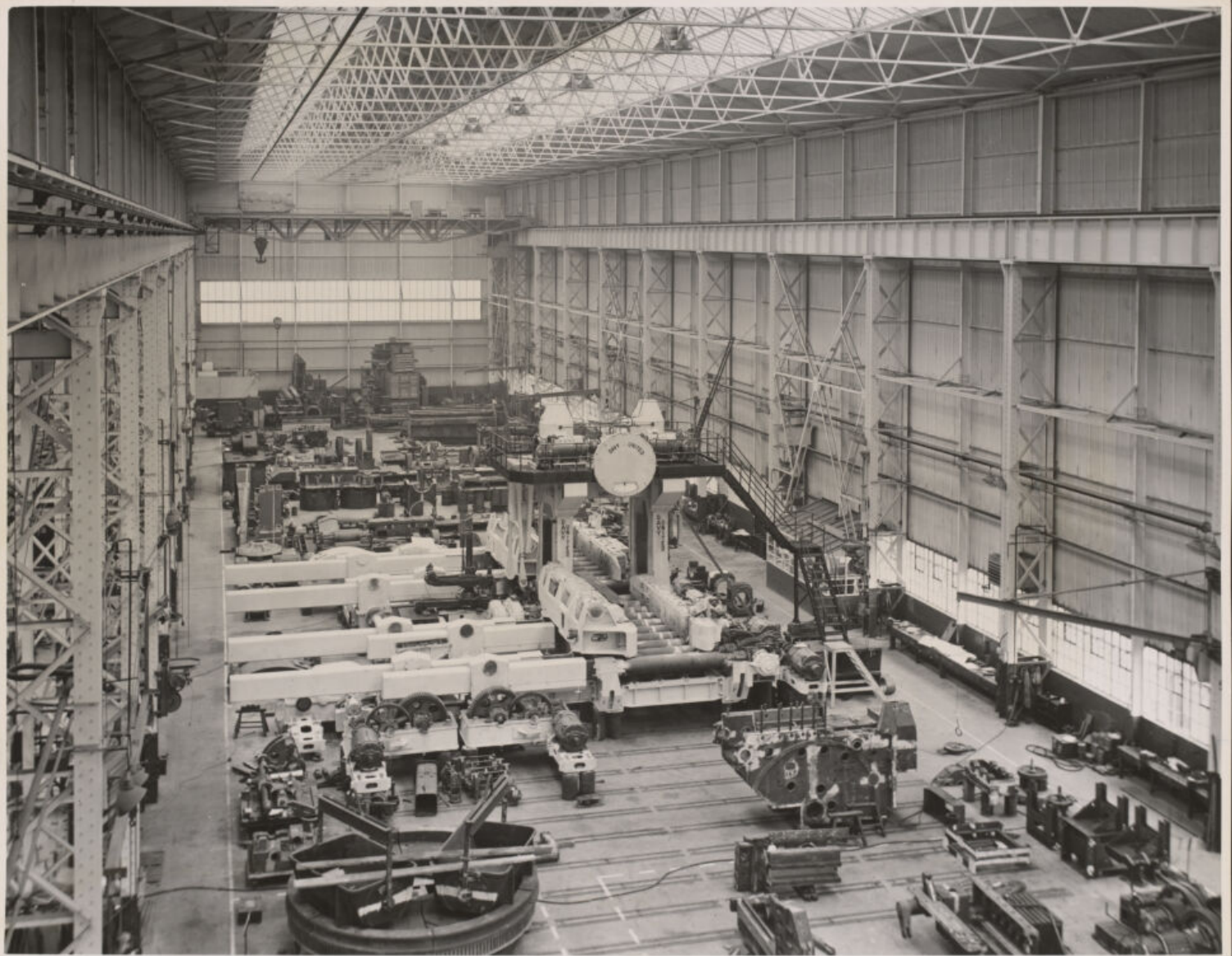

Smith, Publicity Officer, 17th January, 1957. No. 3069. A modern heavy erecting shop showing the assembly of a large 42" reversing blooming mill almost complete on its floor. This shop has overhead cranes capable of lifting single pieces of 125 tons weight, special erection beds fitted in the floor, a floor area of some 40,000 square feet, a height to the crane rails of 55 feet and easy access for incoming material from the machine shops and outgoing material for despatch.
