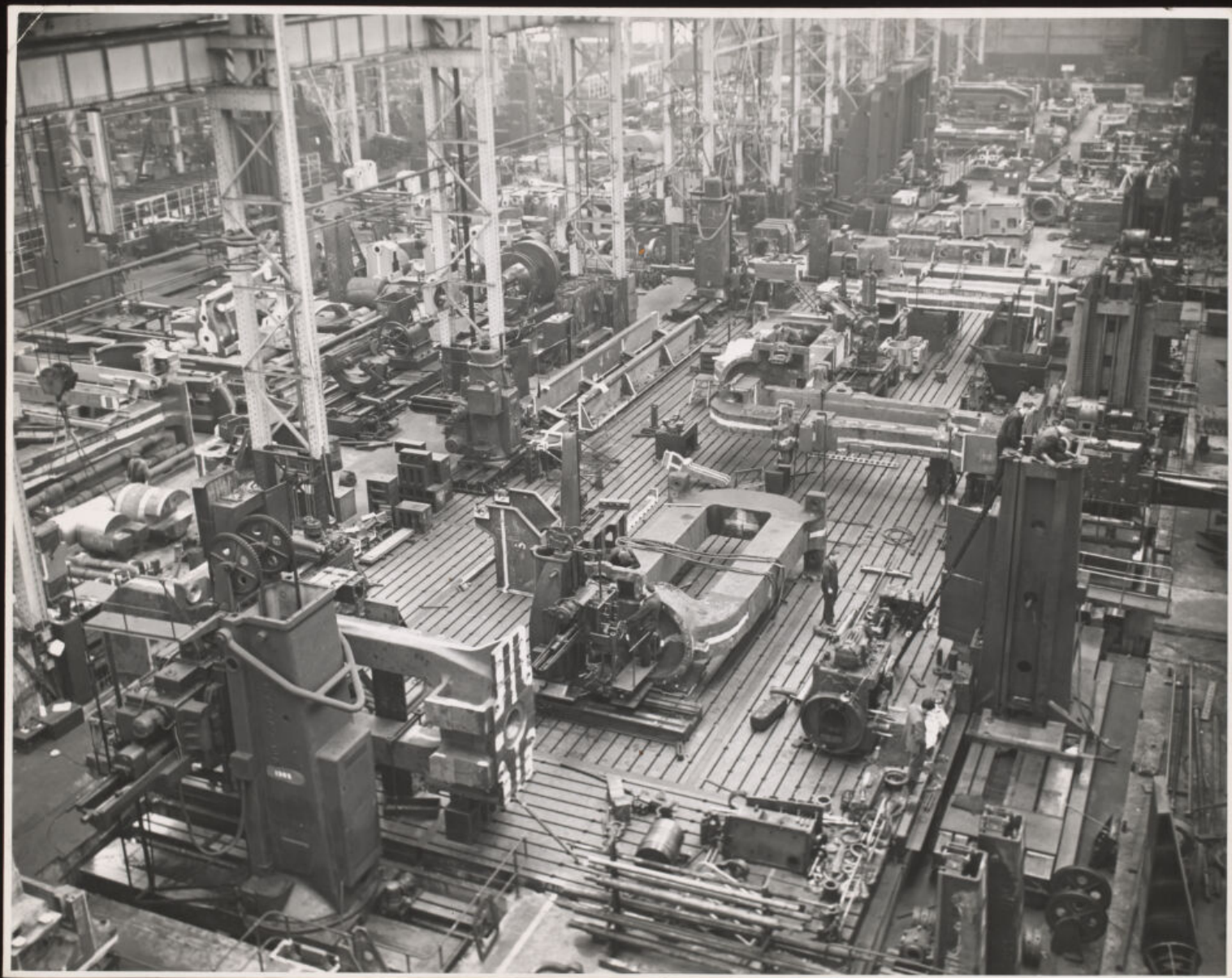

Engineering shop conditions in the firm of Davy and United Engineering Company, Ltd., Park Iron Works, Sheffield 4. One of a series of fourteen photographs supplied by Mr. F.R. Smith, Publicity Officer, 17th January, 1957. No. 3676. A modern heavy machine shop capable of handling pieces of around 125 tons individual weight. Notice the extensive spacing given to all machines, the maintenance of clear gang-ways and an adequate working height in the shop, in this case 55 feet to the crane rails, with overhead cranes of 100 tons and 125 tons capacity. Compare with No. 4389.
