# PAPER ECONOMY

The Covers have always been interleaved with paper to facilitate easy separation but this is no longer possible. The circles come apart quite easily when immersed in water.

# RUBBER BANDS

The Ministry of supply will not allow Rubber Bands to be distributed with Jam Pot Covers. Use string or cotton to hold cover in position while damp—the cover will contract when drying which automatically seals jar.

# DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Place Wax Tissue on top of Jam. Moisten the Transparent Cover and affix over top of jar. As it dries the cover will contract, giving a complete air-tight sealing.
