FLOWERS OF AUSTRALIA

LARGE CHRISTMAS BELL (Blandfordia grandiflora).

There are five species of Christmas Bells in Australia; three are in New South Wales, two in Queensland and one in Tasmania. The flowers illustrated are fairly common in the bush country north of Sydney in French's Forest.

CHRISTMAS BUSH (Ceratopetalum gummiferum). The small red flowers of the Christmas Bush have become as much a symbol of Christmas to the Australian as holly is to the English. The bush is now commonly cultivated.

MISTLETOE (Muellerina eucalyptifolia) occurs on the coastal plains of Queensland and New South Wales. A semi-parasitic plant, it produces sticky berries which are attractive to fruit-eating birds. The birds act as the agent that spreads the seeds to other trees.

CHRISTMAS BEETLE.

These beautiful beetles are seen and heard around Christmas time.
