All the above-mentioned goods are warranted PURE, and of the nature, substance, and quality therein described, within the meaning of the Sale of Food and Drug Acts, and are sold as such. They are also guaranteed to comply with the Ministry of Health Condensed Milk Regulations 1923 and Public Health (Preservatives, etc., in Food) Regulations 1925 and 1926, so far as applicable. In every case of a sample being taken by a Food Inspector, the duplicate sample left with you must be sent to us at once in exactly the condition in which it is received, together with the batch marks on the label of the tin concerned.

CONDITIONS OF SALE

All goods of the Company (whether bought directly from the Company or through a dealer or otherwise howsoever) are sold upon the following Conditions, which are to be taken in every case as part of the Contract of Sale.

- (1) None of the goods shall be re-sold at prices (net) below the respective standard retail cash prices advertised in the Company's current Price List except when re-sold to a trade purchaser.
- (2) None of the goods shall be re-sold to a trade purchaser at prices (net) below or above the standard wholesale prices advertised in the Company's current Price List.
- (3) Provided that if goods are sold to a consumer on Credit, or are sold to a trade purchaser on terms of credit more favourable than the Company's terms to the dealer, in either case a reasonable addition may be made to the standard prices to cover such credit. A reasonable charge may also be added for carriage to the consumer where goods are delivered elsewhere than at the seller's place of business.
- (4) None of the goods shall be re-sold to anyone except on the terms that the purchaser shall and does bind himself to observe and perform all these Conditions (including this Condition).
- (5) None of the goods shall be sold to a trade purchaser, or re-sold by a trade purchaser, except at a shop, office or warehouse included in the ordinary Local Directory, and none of the goods shall be sold or re-sold to a trade purchaser unless such purchaser has such a shop, office, or warehouse as aforesaid.
- (6) None of the goods shall be re-sold except under their original labels, and such labels shall not be altered or obliterated.
- (7) Any person who has re-sold any of the goods to a purchaser who fails to observe or perform these Conditions will, on being indemnified by the Company, take legal proceedings to enforce such Conditions at the request of the Company, or, if so required by the Company allow the Company to take such proceedings in his name, and in any case such person will afford every reasonable assistance to the Company to enable such Conditions to be enforced.

CLAIMS FOR DAMAGE, SHORTAGE, OR NON-DELIVERY

Railway Companies and Carriers will not entertain claims, unless made on them within the times specified in their Conditions of Carriage.

In the case of non-delivery of the whole or part consignment, damage or shortage of tins, customers must immediately claim "In writing" on the Railway Companies or Carriers, at their end, and also notify us at the same time, giving us invoice date and Reference, and particulars of shortage.

Customers must state on delivery sheet the actual shortage, whether tins or cases.

We cannot entertain claims for damage or shortage in reference to goods which have been collected by trader against our Delivery Order and for which a clear signature has been given, neither can we hold ourselves responsible for goods which have passed through another trader's warehouse, in both instances the goods having passed beyond our control.
