This one-day conference is designed to help health professionals, including health visitors, community nurses, school nurses, dietitians and general practitioners in counselling patients and clients on the nutritional needs of children.

The conference forms part of the National Dairy Council's Making Sense of Food campaign, launched in 1992 in response to the government's 'Health of the Nation' initiative and COMA Panel's 'Dietary Reference Values for Food Energy and Nutrients in the UK' report. The campaign aims to help health professionals and the media communicate clear and effective nutrition messages in order for the public to make healthier choices about the food they eat.

The speakers, all experts in their field, will discuss aspects of diet and nutrition pertinent to the needs of children, highlighting new research and focusing on issues of particular importance to child health and growth. The conference will also address the difficult question of how best to communicate good nutrition messages direct to children.

It is hoped that the meeting will assist delegates in recognising potential nutritional problems and in giving appropriate dietary advice in a form that parents and children can act upon.

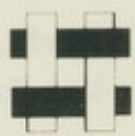
