CONTRA-INDICATIONS, WARNINGS, ETC.

At the present time, there are no known specific contra-indications to the use of Merital 25.

Teratogenic studies in animals have not revealed any adverse effects due to Merital 25, but, in common with all other drugs, Merital 25 should not be used in pregnancy unless there are compelling reasons for doing so. Merital 25 may antagonise the hypotensive effects of adrenergic neurone-blocking drugs (e.g. bethanidine, guanethidine and debriso-quine), and patients taking these drugs may require restabilisation on a higher dose of their anti-hypertensive therapy. Merital 25 may potentiate both the therapeutic and adverse effects of levodopa and other dopamine agonists used in the treatment of Parkinson's disease.

All available evidence has indicated that Merital 25 is exceptionally well tolerated, and there has been a notable lack of cardiovascular effects other than mild palpitations. However, until more specific information is obtained, Merital 25 should be used with caution in patients with ischaemic heart disease.

Merital 25 has not been used in conjunction with electroconvulsive therapy but there is no reason to believe that such a combination will lead to any adverse effects.

Merital 25 has been given to patients immediately following treatment with monoamine oxidase inhibitors, without ill-effects. However, caution should be observed in the use of Merital 25 in conjunction with monoamine oxidase inhibitors since Merital 25 inhibits the synaptic re-uptake of the biogenic amines noradrenaline, dopamine and, to a lesser extent, serotonin.

The treatment of overdosage with Merital 25 is symptomatic. The stomach should be emptied as soon as possible by gastric lavage and the patient admitted to hospital. General supportive measures should be undertaken where indicated.

Adverse effects, if they occur, tend to be mild and transient. Reported adverse effects have included palpitations, nausea, headache, dryness of the mouth and dizziness.







Presentation

Metenix 5 tablets contain 5 mg metolazone.

Uses

Metenix 5 is a diuretic for use in the treatment of mild and moderate hypertension. Metenix 5 may be used in conjunction with non-diuretic antihypertensive agents and in these circumstances it is usually possible to achieve satisfactory control of blood pressure with a reduced dose of the non-diuretic agent. Patients who have become resistant to therapy with these agents may respond to the addition of Metenix 5 to their antihypertensive regimen.

Dosage and administration

The recommended initial dose in mild and moderate hypertension is 5 mg daily. After three to four weeks, the dose may be reduced if necessary to 5 mg on alternate days as maintenance therapy.

Contra-indications

Metenix 5 is contra-indicated in electrolyte deficiency states, anuria, coma or pre-comatose states associated with liver cirrhosis; also in patients with known allergy or hypersensitivity to metolazone.

Warnings

The dosage of concurrently administered cardiac glycosides may require adjustment. Metenix 5 may aggravate the increased potassium excretion associated with steroid therapy or diseases such as cirrhosis or severe ischaemic heart disease. Latent diabetes may become manifest or the insulin requirements of diabetic patients may increase.

Precautions

Because of the antihypertensive effects of metolazone it may be possible to reduce the dosage of concurrently administered non-diuretic antihypertensive agents. The use of Metenix 5 during the first trimester of pregnancy should be subject to the normal precautions which apply to any drug given at this time. If Metenix 5 is given to nursing

mothers metolazone will be present in the breast milk.

Caution should be exercised during Metenix 5 therapy in patients liable to electrolyte deficiency. Fluid and electrolyte balance should be carefully monitored during therapy, particularly if Metenix 5 is used concurrently with other diuretics; prolonged therapy with Metenix 5 may result in hypokalaemia. Serum potassium levels should be determined at regular intervals and, if necessary, potassium supplementation should be instituted. Chloride deficit, hyponatraemia and a low salt syndrome may also occur, particularly when the patient is also on a diet with restricted salt intake. Hypomagnesaemia has been reported as a consequence of prolonged diuretic therapy.

Side-effects

Metenix 5 is generally well tolerated. There have been occasional reports of headache, anorexia, vomiting, abdominal discomfort, muscle cramps and dizziness. There have been isolated reports of urticaria, leucopenia, tachycardia, chills and chest pain. Hyperuricaemia or azotaemia may occur during treatment with Metenix 5, particularly in patients with impaired renal function. On rare occasions clinical gout has been reported.
