### If HIV-infected, at first you may have—

**►** No symptoms

## Later, you may have—

- **▶** Fever
- **►** Fatigue
- Diarrhea
- Skin rashes
- Night sweats
- ► Loss of appetite
- ► Swollen lymph glands
- Significant weight loss
- Lack of resistance to infection
- Furry white spots in the mouth
- Dry cough or shortness of breath
- ► Memory or movement difficulties
- ► Red or purplish spots on the body

Having any of these signs or symptoms may indicate symptomatic HIV infection or AIDS. Only a doctor can tell you what your signs or symptoms mean.
