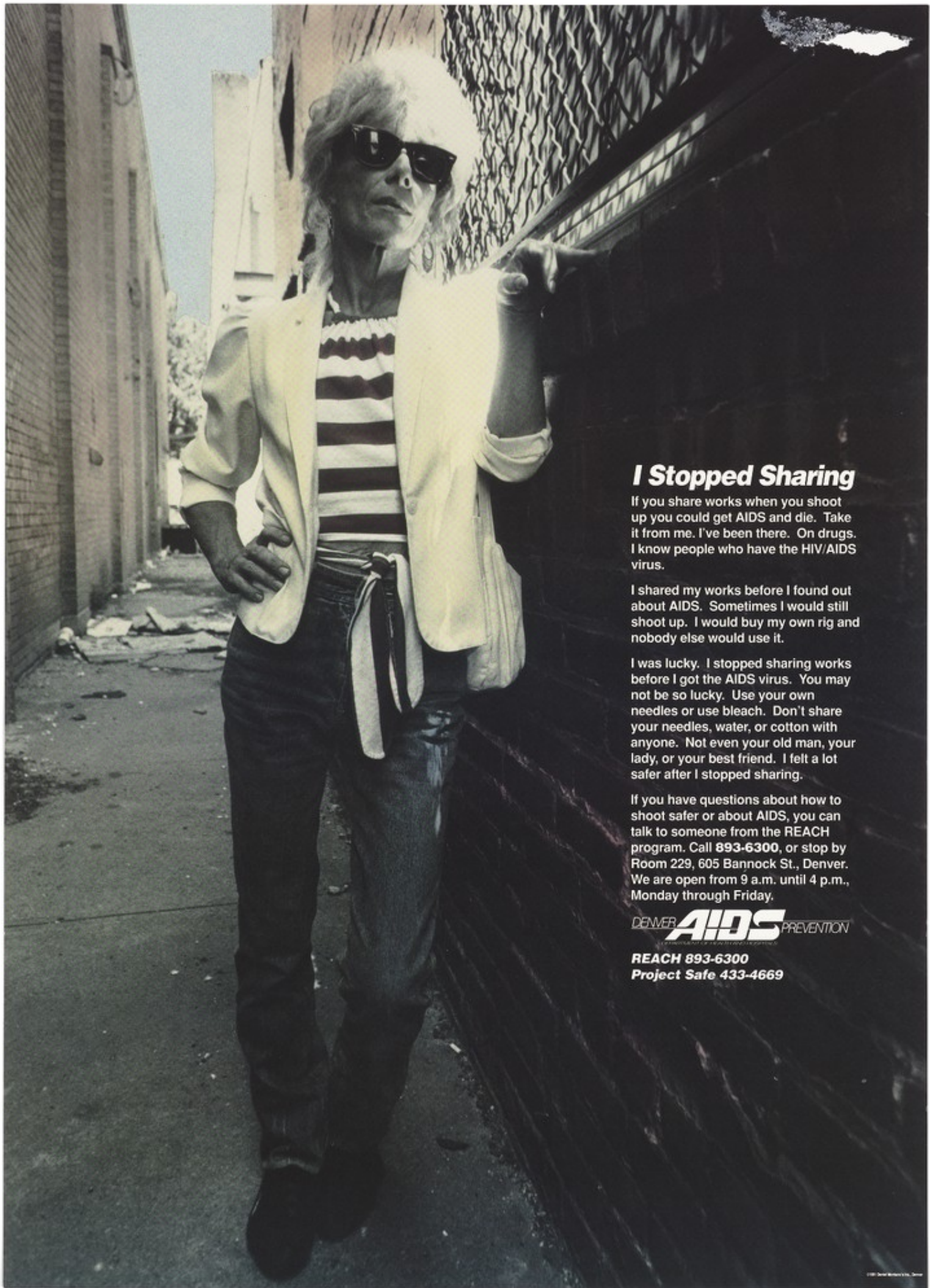

## ***I Stopped Sharing***

If you share works when you shoot up you could get AIDS and die. Take it from me. I've been there. On drugs. I know people who have the HIV/AIDS virus.

I shared my works before I found out about AIDS. Sometimes I would still shoot up. I would buy my own rig and nobody else would use it.

I was lucky. I stopped sharing works before I got the AIDS virus. You may not be so lucky. Use your own needles or use bleach. Don't share your needles, water, or cotton with anyone. Not even your old man, your lady, or your best friend. I felt a lot safer after I stopped sharing.
