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AIDS: WHO IS AT RISK ?

What an individual "does" and not what he/she "is" determines the risk of infection.



Each and everyone of us is at risk.

Certain behaviours carry particularly high risk of transmission:

- Those who have sex with multiple partners, especially when condoms are not used.
- Injecting drug users who share contaminated needles.
