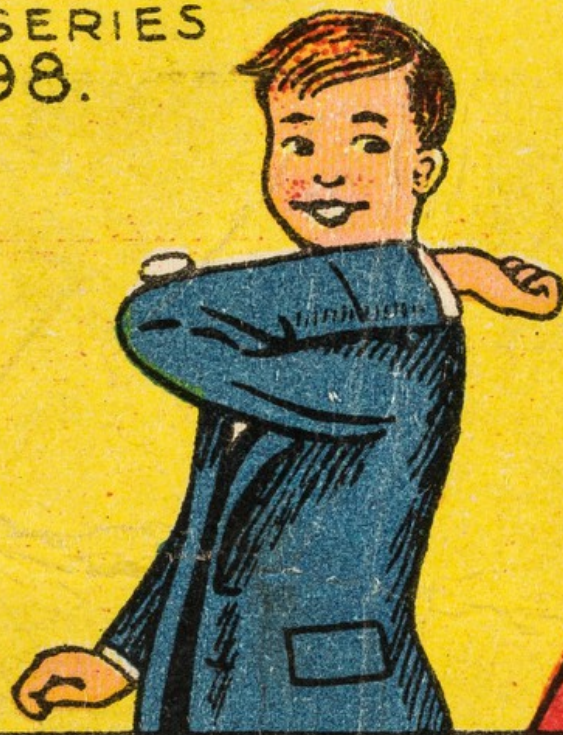

**Solution.**—Place a penny upon your arm, just below elbow, as shown, swing the forearm swiftly down, making a cup of the hand, and coin will easily be caught. A little practice, and 2 or 3 coins can be caught in the same way.
