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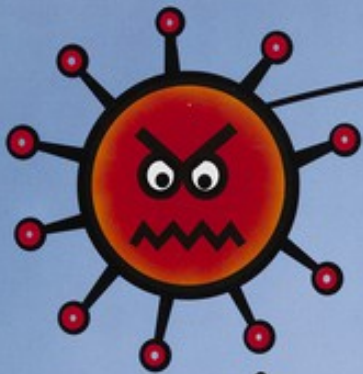
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Inside the Immune System



Antigen: Bad germs or viruses that enter the body and weaken the immune system. Antigens make us sick!



Helper T-Cell (CD4): Boss of the Immune System. Helper T-Cell looks for bad antigens and calls the B-Cells to tell them to make antibodies (fighters).



B-Cells: The Immune System's factory. The B-Cell makes antibodies (fighters) to kill the bad antigens.



Antibody: Fighters of our Immune System. Antibodies kill the bad antigens in our bodies. Antibodies keep us healthy!



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
