LAY CASES DEFINITION FOR EPI TARGET DISEASES

MEASLES

History of fever and rash
and any of the following:-

- cough,
- runny nose and /or
- red eyes

NEONATAL TETANUS:

Any neonatal death or a child born normal who stopped
sucking and developed stiffness
and/or jerking muscles
and/or who died during the first month of life

AFP (Suspected Poliomyelitis)

Sudden weakness or paralysis in the leg(s) and or arm(s)
not caused by injury.
