DANGER SIGNALS OF MENTAL ILLNESS

- 1. Prolonged loss of appetite, lack of sleep, loss of interest and feeling that life is not worth living.
- 2. Shifting bodily pains including headaches and heaviness of the head, this usually ends up worsening one's health, and affects family and social relationships.
- 3. Excessive intake of alcohol and other drugs which interferes with one's health and leads to neglect of family and social responsibilities.
- Bizarre symptoms like talking to oneself, hearing voices, confusion and restlessness.
- 5. Inability to spend one's time, money and other resources appropriately.
- 6. Inability to establish good inter-personal relationships especially at family level.
- 7. Neglecting expected personal, family and social responsibilities.
