THE BREAD CODE

- 1 Buy only as much bread as you know you will need. Don't buy a large loaf if a small one will do.
- 2 Don't ask for bread in a restaurant unless you mean to eat it.
- 3 Learn how to keep bread fresh; it should be wrapped in a clean, dry cloth, and kept in an airy place. If you use a bin, see that it lets in air—either by air-holes or keeping the lid tilted.
- 4 If, in spite of your care, you sometimes get stale ends, use them up in cooking—or, as a last resort, put them in the pig-food bin. Never, never put them in the dustbin.
