DIRECTIONS FOR OUTWARD APPLICATION. Shake the Bottle and well rub it in twice a day. For the Worms in Sheep occasioned by the Fly, pour a little into the wound and rub the part affected twice a day.

DIRECTIONS FOR USING IT AS A DRENCH. In cases of Inflammation, Gripes, &c., for a Horse or Cow, half-a pint to be given in a quart of Gruel or some Flax Seed Tea. For the Scour in Calves, one-third or half the quantity according to age. Dose for a Sheep, two table-spoonfuls. Young Lambs, a tea-spoonful or two according to age, which should always be given in some warm Gruel or Flax Seed Tea.

N.B.—These valuable Oils should be given directly the first symptoms appear.
