THE LIVING WITHOUT CRUELTY EXHIBITION was launched in 1987 in response to increasing public interest in a lifestyle which does not involve the exploitation of animals, humans or the environment. Since then, several imitation 'green' exhibitions have come and gone, but Living Without Cruelty has continued to expand. Each year it has attracted more visitors and more exhibitors.

THE EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors cover a whole range of important social and environmental issues - conservation, human rights, vegetarianism, ethical investment, humane medical research, healthy living, natural medicines, third world concerns, animal rights, cruelty-free cosmetics, clothing and household goods. As well as ethical commercial companies promoting cruelty-free and environmentally-friendly products, many pressure groups and charities also attend. Last year's exhibitors included groups as diverse as Lynx, Amnesty International, Zoocheck, Animal Aid, RSPCA and Campaign Against the Arms Trade. In other words, there is almost everything you need in order to learn about a cruelty-free lifestyle. It is a great way to become more informed, an ideal opportunity to purchase products which support the Living Without Cruelty ethic and it's also a great day out.

LECTURES, FILMS AND ENTERTAINMENT

The exhibition also features a full film and lecture programme. And for those who prefer something a little lighter, there is the popular Living Without Cruelty fashion show and the entertaining 'green' puppet show, plus music in the vegetarian restaurant area.

Unlike most other exhibitions there are no extra charges for films, demonstrations and lectures.
