

Replying to your telephone message on Friday last, the following will give you details of the exact cost of the lamps.

The above cost does not include the 16c.p. 'Osram' lamp.. This latter works out at 3/- net. *extra for each.*

If the above lamp holders are sold I consider they should reasonably fetch actual cost price. The expenses of my own time, correspondence, transport and the idea as a whole are not included in any of the above charges.

There are 34 lamp holders available for disposal.

Whoever purchases these lamps might also like to purchase the plug switches, of which there are about 1½ dozen. These should fetch 1/- each.


