It is most Humbly submitted
to His Majesty.

That, as the duties of the
Inspector of Regimental Hospitals
are equally extensive and laborious
with those of the Physician and
Surgeon General to His Majesty's
Forces, Mr Ruski should, from
the 25th day of December 1799,
inclusive, be allowed the like
rate of Pay, as the Physician
and Surgeon General viz £20
per day subject to the usual
deductions; the same to be in
lieu of the Pay and Allowances
of every description hitherto
received by him; and that the
necessary disbursements for a
Secretary to the Medical Board,
and for Clerks, Office &c. should in
future be paid by the Agent
for Hospitals; but that the
expenses under those heads
should continue subject to the
management and controul of
the Inspector of Regimental
Hospitals, and ^{be} certified by
him. -
