I bought to day a set
of preparation instruments,
33 pieces with black wooden
handles, some also with mother
of pearl & horn handles, in a
black wooden box, 22 x 13 x 3½"
impressed "Preparation
Malliard". The box is iron
bound with iron handles on
both sides, the instruments rest
on a sort of tray, that can be
lifted out of the box.

The instruments are
saws, knives, chisels, auger
& bits, brushes & pincers all of
steel, highly polished and very
neatly finished

They were made about
1700/20, price ^{sh} 80/- plus
postage, eventually I would
send them for inspection.


