





We have now unpacked and carefully checked with your list, the contents of the eight cases from Geneva. We agree all the items with the exception that we are only able to find seven instead of eight small silhouette pictures (line 9, folio 221), and are unable to find the two ivory relief busts (line 10, folio 221) and the brass tea pot modern (line 18, folio 221). We however, found several other curios not specified on your list, and we enclose particulars, with rough drawings, of them.
