This bust was found at Mèze , a small town in the department of Herault, in making excavations prior to the construction of a house, it is certainly authentic. However, I am sending it to you on approval only and you will not be obliged to buy it unless it pleases you when you have seen it. If it does not suit you, you will return it carriage paid to my address.
