Dear Mr. Kris.

I am writing to you at Mr. Wellcome's request to make you acquainted with a matter of interest to him. It was his wish that I should tell you about it, but I did not receive his instructions until about an hour before I left Vienna (9.0 pm) by which time you had left your office.

It is Mr. Wellcome's wish that you treat ~~you~~ this matter as strictly confidential, as for various reasons he does not wish his name to appear.

Some year or so since Mr. Wellcome learned that a

gentleman named Dr Friedlowski
of Kreisbach, near Wilhelmsburg
via St Pölten, had a collection of
old prints of medical men &
that this collection numbering
10,000 pictures was to be sold
for 2000 Kronen. Mr Wellcome
instructed me to go and see
them & report upon their value,
he wanted to know if they were
old genuine prints or merely
cuttings from papers, if they
were large or small, what was
their condition & age, in short
he wished fullest particulars of
them. I went to Kreisbach &
saw them & have fully
reported upon them & have
stated their value in my
opinion. As I was not able
to go to Kreisbach until last
Saturday, owing to Dr Friedlowski

not being able to receive me, there was not time to hear from Mr. Wellcome as to whether he wished me to purchase them, or to leave the matter alone. So I was obliged to leave Vienna with the business still unsettled. I wish now to leave it your hands, to put you in possession of all the facts & then to ask you to await further information, either from Mr. Wellcome direct or from me.

There are 1780 portraits & the price asked is 700 Kronen, but I have suggested the purchase of 750 of these at the price of 1300 Kronen, ~~but~~ it is most likely if a bid of 200 were offered him he would accept the offer. Should Mr. Wellcome desire to purchase this lot, it should be described as, "the set
