## ANNUAL MEETING, 1914.

THE ANNUAL MEETING was held at the Royal College of Physicians, Pall Mall East, London, S.W., on Monday, February 23rd, at 3 p.m., when the Chair was taken by Sir Thomas Barlow, Bart., K.C.V.O., M.D., President of the Royal College of Physicians.

Amongst those present were Sir George Savage, Dr. Coupland and Mr. A. H. Trevor (Commissioners in Lunacy), Dr. Henry Rayner, Dr. R. Percy Smith, Dr. Stansfield (Medical Superintendent, L.C.C. Asylum, Bexley), Dr. Taylor (Medical Superintendent, East Sussex Asylum, Hellingly), Dr. Worth (Medical Superintendent, Middlesex County Asylum, Tooting), Dr. Pasmore (Medical Superintendent, Croydon Mental Hospital), Dr. Shuttleworth, Dr. Bower, Dr. Chambers, Dr. Gilmour (St. Luke's Hospital, E.C.), Dr. Seward, Dr. Elgee (L.C.C. Asylum, Colney Hatch), Drs. Colliers and W. B. Keith (Kent County Asylum, Barming Heath), Dr. Lloyd, R.N., Dr. Carre-Smith, Dr. Elcum.

The Report and Balance Sheet for 1913 were read by the Secretary.

The adoption of the Report was proposed by Sir George Savage, seconded by Dr. Taylor and supported by Mr. A. H. Trevor, the Rev. H. Stephens (Chaplain of the Essex County Asylum, Brentwood), and Mr. H. L. Woolcombe.

The re-election of the President, Vice-Presidents and the Council was proposed by Dr. Stansfield and seconded by Dr. Coupland.

The proceedings terminated with a vote of thanks to the Chairman, proposed by Dr. Henry Rayner and seconded by Dr. Percy Smith.

## REPORT OF THE COUNCIL.

---

*From January 1st to December 31st, 1913.*

---

The Council of the After Care Association for Poor Persons discharged recovered from Asylums for the Insane again has pleasure in presenting the Annual Report.

One of the most important events of the Association's year has been the consideration by the Council of extending the work so as to receive cases discharged on trial, as suggested in the Paper read at the Annual Meeting on February 13th, 1913, by Dr. Hubert Bond, Commissioner in Lunacy. A Special Committee was appointed, consisting of Dr. Rayner, Sir George Savage, Dr. Hubert Bond, Dr. Percy Smith, Dr. Lord, Dr. Stoddart, Dr. Worth, Dr. Bower and Mrs. Marriott Cooke, to consider if the extension were possible.

After a most careful consideration of detail they drew up a report recommending to the Council that the suggestion be tried from November 1st in connection with certain Asylums in the South of England. Since then several applications have been received on behalf of such cases, and at present the results have been satisfactory. This has, however, thrown considerably more work on the Council and officers of the Association, and has necessitated a meeting of the Council every fortnight with a rota of Chairmen for the increased number of meetings. It is hoped if the plan succeeds to extend the offer of similar help to various other Asylums during 1914. It is also proposed to hold a Special Meeting of Subscribers at an early date to alter the Title and the Constitution, so that the Association may be able to conform permanently to the altered conditions of the work.

Although the total receipts have increased owing to legacies, it will be seen that the actual income from subscriptions and donations has slightly decreased, and that fresh Contributors are therefore urgently needed.

**Legacies.**—During the year the Association has received a further instalment from the Solicitors of the Estate of the late Miss E. W. Walker, amounting to £166 13s. 4d., and the sum of £1,000 under the Will of the late Mr. A. H. Harman. Owing to the uncertainty of the money market during the greater part of 1913, and the great fluctuations which took place in all Trustee stocks, together with the high Bank Rate which prevailed during the year, the Council thought it better in the interests of the Association to place these amounts on deposit with their Bankers (The Union of London and Smiths Bank, Victoria Street, Westminster), at the current rates of interest.

**Cases.**—During the past year applications on behalf of 377 persons were received, of whom 11 were on trial. Of these, 228 were women and 149 were men. Of this number, 106 were cases from the London County Asylums, 197 from other County and

Borough Asylums, 18 from Mental Hospitals and Licensed Houses, and 56 from other Institutions or private sources. Of these, 119 had been assisted in various ways during previous years and 258 were before the Council for the first time. Particulars of a few typical cases are the following:—

#### WOMEN.

- [3738]. A respectable young servant, in poor physical health, whose home surroundings were not desirable, was placed in a Cottage Home, a situation found and an outfit provided. As she did not improve, she was sent to the seaside and then placed in a country situation, where she is doing very well and is decidedly stronger.
- [3765]. A respectable married woman, with a very sad history, was sent to a Cottage Home, an outfit given and a situation found, where she did well and was able to support her youngest child.
- [3776]. A married woman in very poor circumstances, was sent to one of the Cottage Homes, and after several weeks returned to the care of her young family, greatly improved in health and spirits.
- [3780]. A middle-aged widow, was boarded out in a Country Home and clothing given. Her old firm were seen and consented to re-engage her, and she is doing extremely well at their wholesale branch.
- [3814]. A middle-aged woman, had been mentally ill for some years, and who, on her recovery, could not trace any friends or relations. She was boarded out in the country, clothing given and a situation found. This she has kept very satisfactorily, and as she recently required an entirely new set of teeth, this has been provided, and she is now paying the Association in monthly instalments.
- [3856]. A domestic servant, whose friends were quite unable to receive her, was boarded out for a time, helped with her clothing and then returned to her former mistress's service. Later she developed a physical complaint, an in-patient's letter for a hospital was secured for her.
- [3904]. A good cook, was boarded out in the country, an excellent situation found for her, and an outfit provided. She writes very happily, and her mistress reports well of her.

#### MEN.

- [3723]. A well educated lad, very lame, was sent to the seaside for some weeks, work was then obtained, at which he is doing very well.
- [3739]. A superior man, of good education, without friends or means, who had been an auditor on a railway abroad, was boarded out in London, taught some cooking, and obtained a berth in an hotel.

This he recently left for a better post, and he has voluntarily repaid the whole cost of his maintenance.

- [3763]. A man of good character, who after a time in a Country Home was boarded out in London. He found work again as a clerk in a wholesale business, and has repaid the greater part of his maintenance, and has now £12 in the bank.
- [3855]. A very respectable youth, whose former employment was unsuitable, was sent to a Seaside Home, and found work on board ship, where he is very happy.
- [3882]. A respectable middle-aged man, food and clothing were given, advertisements inserted, and work found for himself and his wife together as indoor servants, where they are happy and giving every satisfaction.
- [3892]. An orphan boy, whose young sisters were out at work, was sent to the sea, then boarded out in London and work found, where he is earning good wages and is now able to help the others.
- [3902]. A jeweller's assistant, in great poverty, with several young children. Clothing and food were given and advertisements inserted by which he obtained a good berth, where he is doing well.

One of the most important functions of the Association is finding suitable occupation for persons who, although recovered, would probably have great difficulty in re-starting themselves in life. The bestowal of a large amount of personal care and individual attention upon each case is necessitated, and the careful investigation of the suitability of those with whom they are placed. The result of this part of the work is far greater than the mere supplying of temporary homes, clothing, or grants for maintenance and tools, important though these may be. The strongest possible evidence of the utility of this Charity is shown not only in the comfort and aid given, but in the prevention of relapse, many who have had previous attacks remaining well since they have been under the influence of the staff of the Association.

Since the work of the Association commenced, with the appointment of the present Secretary, 5,171 cases have been considered by the Council, of these a very large number from time to time, although suitably re-started in various spheres of work, require counsel in many ways, and call at the office to see some member of the staff. Advice is freely given and frequently enables them to overcome satisfactorily any possible difficulties, and tends to prevent mental strain which is particularly undesirable in the cases with which the Association deals.

**Vice-Presidents.**—During the year the following have kindly consented to become Vice-Presidents:—Dr. Heurtley Sankey and Mrs. Hack Tuke, both of whom for many years have been members of the Council, and very warm supporters of the Association. Dr. Rotherham and Miss Dendy (members of the Board of Control) and Mrs. Hume Pinsent (hon. member of the same), have also been elected.

**Council.**—The following have kindly consented to fill vacancies on the Council:—Dr. Worth (Medical Superintendent of the Middlesex County Asylum, Tooting), Mr. Goodrich (Chairman of the London County Asylum, Hanwell), Mr. Gabain (member of the Hill End Asylum Committee) and Mrs. Steen, also Miss Cécile Matheson as representative of the Birmingham Branch.

**Meetings.**—Five meetings have been held during the year:—*(a)* At the Palace, Bromley (by the kind permission of Mr. and Mrs. Coles Child), Mr. Coles Child presiding. Speeches were made by Sir George Savage, Dr. Percy Smith, Dr. Wolseley Lewis, Canon Donald Tate, Canon Barker and Mr. Roxby. *(b)* In the garden of All Saints' Vicarage, Highgate, by the kind invitation of the Rev. F. H. A. and Mrs. Hawkins, when the chair was taken by the Hon. John Mansfield (Lord Chancellor's Visitor in Lunacy), and addresses were given by Mrs. Alfred Sykes, Mr. Stanley Keith and Mr. Roxby. *(c)* In the garden at Cane Hill, by the kindness of Sir James and Lady Moody. The chair was taken by Sir James Moody, and the meeting addressed by Sir George Savage, Dr. Percy Smith and Mr. Roxby. *(d)* At Rubery Hill, through the invitation of Dr. and Mrs. Suffern, a meeting was held on behalf of the Birmingham Branch. The chair was taken by Councillor D. Davis, and an address was given by Mr. Roxby. *(e)* At York, by the kind invitation of the Committee of Bootham Park and Dr. Jeffery, the chair being taken by the Rev. A. D. Tupper-Carey (Canon Residentiary of York), and addresses were given by the Rev. J. Watson (Canon Residentiary and Sub-Dean of York), Dr. Bedford Pierce and Mr. Roxby. Mr. Roxby also attended the Annual Meeting of the Essex (Brentwood) Branch, which was presided over by Sir Thomas Barrett-Lennard (Chairman of the Asylum Committee), and the Annual Meeting

of the North West Kent Branch at Barming Heath, when Dr. Wolsey Lewis (Medical Superintendent) presided.

To these Boards of Guardians the Council tenders its best thanks for their most useful contributions.

**Guild of Help.**—This Guild has once more rendered valuable assistance during 1913. In addition to many useful presents of clothing, &c., for which the Council is most grateful, the total amount contributed in subscriptions and donations was £42 2s. An At Home was held by the kindness of Mrs. Ironside Bruce, at 10, Chandos Street, on Tuesday, November 25th, when Miss Helen Webb (Hon. Treasurer of the Guild) and Miss Vickers (Assistant Secretary of the Association) spoke.

In order to facilitate the financial arrangements of the Guild the Annual Meeting was held in the early part of January, 1914, not, as before, in the autumn of the preceding year. It took place at the residence of Dr. and Mrs. Coupland, the chair being taken by Miss Helen Webb, M.B. Short addresses were given by Mr. A. H. Trevor and Dr. Coupland (Commissioners in Lunacy) and Mr. Roxby. A Report with Balance Sheet of this Guild is published separately, and all further information may be obtained from the Hon. The following account has been received from the "**Birmingham Affiliated Branch**."—President: The Lord Mayor of Birmingham. This Branch was formed at the beginning of the year, and during that time all patients discharged from the Mental Hospital have been visited by the members of the Case Subcommittee and others. 43 patients have been assisted; 24 women and 19 men. The assistance has been given in various ways, such as finding work, arranging holidays, paying arrears of rent, giving grocery or milk orders, hospital notes or clothing, &c. The Committee endeavours by home visits to keep in continuous touch with all friendless and poor discharged patients, who, besides receiving material help have often much benefited by advice, sympathy and encouragement. Among the female alcoholic patients this work has been particularly successful, as these on their discharge are reported to the British Women's Temperance Association, whose members visit regularly, and have obtained most encouraging results, several patients having been induced to sign the pledge.

"The Committee is now starting in connection with the Brabazon Work Society to teach the inmates of the Mental Hospital various kinds of needlework, with the idea of interesting and brightening their lives. Though this cannot exactly be called 'After Care,' it is intimately connected with the work, as, by means of the lessons, the helpers have an excellent opportunity of getting to know the patients about to be discharged.

"A Drawing-room Meeting was held, by kind permission of Dr. and Mrs. Suffern, on November 19th, at Rubery Hill Asylum. Councillor Davis took the chair, and Mr. Roxby addressed the Meeting."
