Dear Sir

I am sorry I was away when you called to day, regarding the large picture, the principal point is, that being very thickly varnished, the contraction of the old Varnish has tended to crack the paint. To line and clean the picture, and restore the damaged parts without removing the Varnish, would cost about Eight pounds but the most satisfactory way would be to remove the Varnish, restore damages and improve the cracked parts as much as possible this would cost from twelve to fifteen pounds but when the picture is lined, perhaps you would like to see it, and decide.

Regarding the cost of the "Cricket" picture, it was in a very unusual condition, and

and I was sorry to have to charge for
so much time spent on it, with no great
results. However, it will modify the cost
if you will please deduct 5 per cent from
the Gross account.

We can do the Case frame in
white wood, for £4. without the
Glass.
