George 1st

At death of Queen Anne total strength of
Army in Gr. Britain 7,813, and about
5000 in the Irish Establishment. There
were 3 Brit. regts in Flanders (1,895 men) who
did not return till 1715. There were also some
regts and details in the ^{Independent Co.} Colonies.

Army too low reduced by 2 regts of cavalry (700 Horses)
4 regts of foot (22nd, 24th, 53rd, 34th Regts) and
3 regts of Dragoon.

These regts were all reconstituted by George 1st
in first half of 1715. The main regts becoming
30th 31st + 32nd Regts.

In July 1715. 13 regts of Dragoon were raised.
+ 8 Regts of foot (and 10000).

2 Feb. 1716 5 regts Dragoon + 5 of Infantry } arrived
and for the Irish establishment. } 1717

In 1716 - 2 permanent Co. of Artillery raised - the
beginning of a permanent R.A.

"George P. C. R.

"George, Prince of Wales, &c., Guardian
of the Kingdom of Great Britain and his
Majesty's Lieutenant within the same, to
Thomas Braime, Surgeon, greeting.

We do in his Majesty's name constitute
and appoint you to be surgeon to his
Majesty's four Independent Companies
of Foot in his Majesty's Province of New
York in America. You are therefore carefully
and diligently to discharge the duty of surgeon by
doing and performing all and all manner
of things thereto belonging and you are to
obey and follow such orders and directions
as you shall receive from Brigadier Robert
Sturges, his Majesty's Captain General of
the said Province, or any other your superior
officer according to the rules and
Discipline of War. Given at the Court of
St. James the seventh day of December
1716 in the third year of his Majesty's reign.
"By his Royal Highness's Command
"P. Methuen.
"Encl. with the Serj. at War. Rd. Arrol."






