The following objects are presented by E.H. Topham Esq., 26. Coleherne Court, South Kensington, W., and were brought from North Alaska.

No. 1. A Bag of Membrane (probably from the seal) used by the Siwash Indians to keep the clothes dry when canceing. From Yakatat, close to Mt. St. Elias, North Alaska.

A Jacket and Head covering of membrane, worn when canceing No. 2. HMM. in rough weather to keep the body dry. North Alaska.

Fish hooks used for deep sea fishing for halibut by No. 3. HMM. Siwash Indians. The deities ruling the sea and fishing are 3649 43650. rudely carved on the hook, and these are invoked by the fisherman before casting his line. North Alaska. 2 only Storedo

Powder horn, carved, used by the Siwash Indians, North No. 4. Alaska.

No. 5. Amulets and head ornaments used by a shaman of the Siwash 7657,3652 1653-367 Indians, Yakatat, North Alaska.

Charms and amulets of bone and ivory, used by Siwash HMM. No. 6. 7658- 3675 North Alaska. Indians.
