I desire to thank you for your postcard of August 25th and for the interesting incident connected with the Chinese girl who was bitten by a dog.

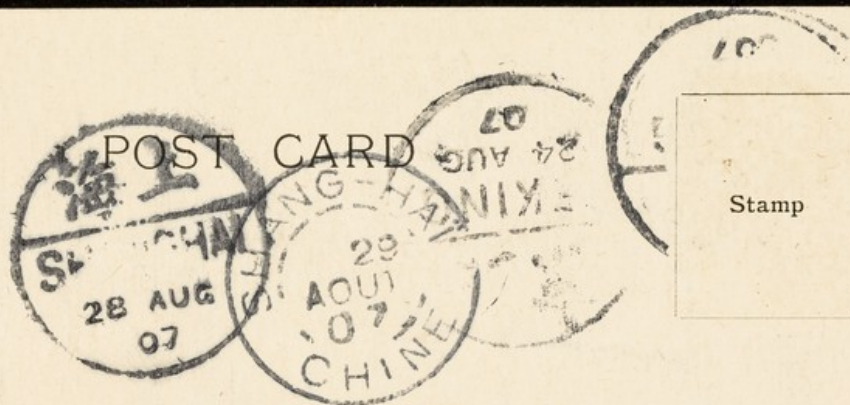
It is very curious how one finds similarity in these old customs among the various races throughout the world.
