I wanted to write to you since more than a year with regard to a picture of a medico, which is on sale in a second hand picture shop, 83, Kilburn High Road, Kilburn N.W., but I am so busy that the matter always escaped my memory. This is a picture by Van Wyck, the man who painted several pictures representing alchemists. It is about 4' by 2'6" and has a large number of figures. It represents a doctor inspecting the usual glass and a woman with a child at the back evidently consulting him. In the foreground there is the peculiar scene, which I have seen on another picture, namely a nigger boy whipping a dressed up monkey, who is trying to steal some fruit.

Since a medical presents no interest to me and since I know you are collecting them, I would advise you to have it inspected. The man wanted £ 21.0.0, the picture is in excellent state, although it will require cleaning, and as far as I could see it is a very fine piece of work and well worth a great deal more.
